There are encouraging signs that the observance of Christianity Month is growing. Individual Christians are paying attention and more churches and church networks are getting involved. It's encouraging to see that some national organisations have been finding out how they can offer support.

This is more of a grassroots movement than an organised co-ordinated effort to persuade church leaders, denominations, and chief executives to take the lead in supporting Christianity Month. Indeed, sometimes those with great responsibility have to act a little like a gatekeeper for their own organisations as they have their own priorities and strategies to focus on. My sense is that in many places those on the ground will be the ones that push and promote Christianity Month.
